Chapter Committees

Annual Golf Outing

This committee is responsible for the Chapter's annual golf outing benefiting Habitat for Humanity & our Scholarship Fund. The committee meets as required.

Communications

This committee is responsible for the communication channels used by the Chapter to communicate with our members. These include our web site, LinkedIn and Twitter. The committee meets as needed.

Nominating

This committee is responsible for the nomination of members for Chapter leadership roles. It is comprised of prior Chapter Presidents (chaired by the most recent past-President) & meets as needed.

Advisory Board

This group guides our Chapter based on their past roles as proven Chapter leaders. The group is comprised of past Chapter Presidents and CFMA National Directors and Officers.

Programs

This committee is responsible for the development and planning of all Chapter meetings, social events and our annual January charity event (excludes the annual golf outing). The committee meets approximately 6 times per year.

Membership

This committee is responsible for the Chapter's membership recruitment and retention efforts. The committee meets approximately 6 times per year often in conjunction with Program Committee meetings.

Education

This committee is responsible for the development of all Chapter's educational offerings. These include Knowledge Networks and a bi-annual state-wide conference held with the IN CPA Society. The committee meets approximately 6 times per year.

Academic Relations/Scholarship

This committee is responsible for the selection process through which the Chapter awards scholarships each year to top accounting students from Indiana state colleges. These students have demonstrated an interest in the construction industry. The committee meets approximately 6 times per year.
